They include policy advocacy to end ICE detention centers, resources for mapping U.S. detention centers and the location of loved ones within these facilities, a bond fund to assist detainees in being released as they await trial, and a legal advice hotline recently featured on "Orange Is The New Black."



Christina Hernandez and Liz Wilson have partnered with local groups Centro Del Pueblo and Cooperation Humboldt. Their goal is to find host families for asylum seekers who have been cleared for release, but do not have an established household to take them in. Along with discussing their organization, they will specifically talk about these efforts, and ways students can participate in the struggle against the immigration detention system.

As a UCLA student, Karla founded UndocuTravelers, a platform that focused on Advance Parole (AP) for DACA recipients. Due to her work on UndocuTravelers, Karla was able to assist thousands of undocumented people with DACA and Advance Parole applications, renewals and FOIAS.


